Analog

- No software needed
- Examples
 - Clocks
 - TVs, CRTs
 - LPs or Records
 - VHS tapes
- Large, takes up a lot of space

Digital

- Need software to work
- Examples
 - Smart watch
 - HDtv, LEDs,
 - Ipod, mp3s
 - DVDs
- Smaller, Store a lot more

Access



Local

- Store data physically on your computer
- Single User at a time
- Limited access from computer only
- Limited expansion takes up a lot of space
- Security (Single Point Access)

Remote

- Distributed Storage of data/Cloud based
- Multiple Users
- Access Offsite Home, Backyard, or Beach
- Unlimited Expansion with out taking up space
- Security (multiple access points)

Software

- Operating Systems
 - Windows

Storage



Units

- 1 Byte = Unit of Data
- 1000 Bytes = 1 Kilobyte (KB)
- 1000 Kilobytes = 1 Megabyte (MB)
- 1000 Megabytes = 1 Gigabyte (GB)
- 1000 Gigabytes 1 Terabyte (TB)

Documents/Photos

- 1 letter or number
- 1 Page (200-250 words)
- 75 pages/20 photos
- 75, 000 pages/500 photos
- 7 Million pages/50,000 photos


